Herta, who co-founded the Stars of Karting in 2000, said, "The karts are purpose-built 125cc machines capable of speeds up to 100 mph. This type of racing is where the vast

majority of racers started their careers, so it is great for a

lot of us to get back to our roots and have an event where you don't have to worry about points or sponsors or anything, just get out there and do what we love."

Bragging Rights Go To The Champ

The winner of tonight's All-Stars Masters Division race will be awarded the prestigious PRI All-Stars Karting Classic Perpetual Trophy. The unique Perpetual Trophy, crafted by Trigard Bronze, honors the winning Masters Division driver and kart chassis manufacturer. The winning kart chassis manufacturer will be given this trophy to keep, then can display it in its booth in the Orange County Convention Center during the PRI Trade Show and in its facility after the Trade Show.

The Perpetual Trophy plate is 19 inches by 12 inches. It is a highly polished aluminum diamond plate design featuring a CNC machined PRI All-Stars Karting Classic logo. The logo is placed off the diamond plate with aluminum bushing to give it a true threedimensional look and feel.

The Masters race winner will join past winners Buddy Rice (2006) and Michael Valiante (2007) with plates affixed to a single border aluminum back plate in honor of the champion. The race winner plates have a 3D CNC machined relief of a helmet along with the year, driver name, and the manufacturer's name. The plates are black and white to resemble a checkered flag. The back plate is also placed off the diamond plate with aluminum bushings to give it a three-dimensional look as well.

Trigard Bronze, a division of Greenwood Inc., manufactures custom CNC machined and 3D relieved bronze and aluminum plaques, signs, awards, trophies, hall of fame displays and donor recognition walls.

"I have great memories of my days in karting in my youth," said Speed. "However, as I have progressed in my career, I am only able to kart for training during the season due to my







ROB HOWDEN: The Voice of Stars of Karting Announces Tonight!

A very important dimension to tonight's kart racing excitement will be heard loud and clear over the track's PA system as Rob Howden, the voice of Stars of Karting, will provide the most up-to-date information in his unique rapid-fire style.

Howden's knowledge and expertise in kart racing is immense. He is the editorin-chief and publisher of four websites for Howden Media Group, Cambridge, Ontario, Canada: eKartingNews.com, eKartingNews.ca, eFormulaCarNews.com and IndoorKartingNews.com.

Howden first got into the sport of karting in 1994 when he was sent to cover the inaugural Barrie Grand Prix, a karting event in southern Ontario, for Performance Racing News (PRN). "I enjoyed the weekend and became very excited about the sport and its affordability, seeing it as a way to finally get behind the wheel myself," Howden said. "Over the next three years, I worked

to develop the karting coverage at PRN and the support of the karting industry in Canada made it possible for the newspaper to add more pages to cover the sport. Our coverage became quite intense and often featured as many as 10 pages, with regular larger pullouts."

In 1997, he signed on as the editor-atlarge for *National Kart News* (NKN), which was the biggest karting publication in the US at the time, Howden said. "I spent two years working for NKN before I struck out on my own to publish *Shifter Kart Illustrated*, a gearbox-only karting publication that worked closely with Superkarts! USA (SKUSA), which led the shifter kart movement in the '90s," Howden said. "It was with SKUSA where I started announcing, taking hold of the microphone for their annual SuperNationals event and the nationwide ProMoto Tour that they ran



from 1999–2003. It was a no-brainer as I was there to cover the races and knew more about the drivers than anyone else. I had keenly listened to many announcers in Canada and drew from my favorites to develop my style."

Howden now announces for the Snap-on Stars of Karting series and other karting and open wheel programs. "In recent years, I've also been lucky to have been able to announce many junior formula series events, including the Formula BMW Americas series, the Star Mazda Championship and the Atlantic Championship," he said. "It's nice to get the chance to call a race with so many of the karters who I have watched move up the ranks."—Nick Gagala

Valiante had a very direct response to why he's returning to the PRI All-Stars Karting Classic this year. "So I can win again," he said. "I really enjoyed the competition. So many world class drivers competed in the event, and the fan participation was unreal.

"The kart performs and responds so quickly. It is really difficult to have a car handle as well as a kart. They are just amazing to drive," Valiante added.

Philippe is also looking forward to the competition. "I choose to race at the PRI

All-Stars Karting Classic because it's a really fun event to promote the sport that gave me my start when I was younger and I also get to hang out with some of my driver friends," he said.

Talented Stars of Karting driver Miller said, "The competition is top notch, which can be seen from the past two races. This year will most likely be the same as the best karters show up as well as some of the best car drivers."

Carlton, a top Stars of Karting driver, said, "I'm sure the race will attract North America's best in both the TAG and Shifter categories. PASSING ZONE!

The race track for this year's PRI All-Stars Karting Classic has been increased in size and redesigned for even more passing!

Spectators at last year's packed PRI All-Stars Karting Classic know that tonight's drivers will be going full throttle toward the checkered flag, with passing at every corner. Even those stalwarts who braved the pouring rain at the inaugural kart race during the 2006 PRI Trade Show witnessed hard charging karting action—albeit very wet and slippery action.

This year a new track configuration has added to the excitement of the PRI All-Stars Karting Classic, as three new turns have been added to the circuit, making a total of seven turns in all.

"These additional corners will add a couple more passing

zones to a circuit that was already producing non-stop passing," said Paul Zalud, president of the Snap-on Stars of Karting. "The track will be short in length compared to an outdoor national and will be a quarter-mile long. It is a minimum of 30-feet wide and will produce a lap time of approximately 22 seconds."

In addition to the great action on the track, come early and enjoy the pre-race 'vibe' in the Snap-on Paddock. With the driver celebrities focusing on dialing in their equipment, the Snap-on Paddock was one of the coolest places to hang out during the entire PRI Trade Show last year!


